from Gisborne to total solar eclipse – airborne observation over water east of NZ – more than 4.5 minutes in the moon’s shadow at 35,000 feet altitude at 290 knots in 9-passenger King Air 350 turboprop aircraft – unforgettable drama as shadow approaches and envelops aircraft – “closest we can come to space travel” \$3,000 for your own window or \$2,000 to share – windows are quite large so sharing should work fine 4 seats and 3 windows available – while they last – contact John Beattie at jrbt@eclipse.net
